Executive Committee Meeting Beverly-Marblehead Sail and Power Squadron June 5, 2019

- 1. Commander Nigro called the meeting to order at 1905, followed by a Moment of Silence for our troops in Harm's Way.
- 2. Attendees: Cdr Nigro; P/C Reed; P/D/C John Bedrossian; Lt/C Walter Riley; I/P/C Pszenny; Lt/C Schoenthal; Joan Thayer;
- 3. A motion to accept the minutes of the April 3, 2019 meeting was made, seconded and approved.
- 4. SEO report
 - a. Five out of seven students passed the MES final exam.
 - b. If all students taking the Marblehead ABC course pass, our total for the spring will be 84 students who passed the course.
 - c. The Weather Seminar will take place at Salem Willows Yacht Cub on July 22nd and 29th.
 - A motion was made, seconded and passed to allow Ray Tilton to provide on the water training for the new owner of a 38-foot Sea Ray at Danversport Marina on a date TBA. The vessel must pass a Vessel Safety Check before training can begin.
 - e. Jack Reed will contact JYC about scheduling class rooms for Cruise Planning (October 15th through December 3rd (Tuesdays) and Junior Navigation (September 23rd through December 23rd) (Mondays).
 - f. The USCGA has asked us to support them in conducting vessel safety checks at Danversport Marina on June 8th.
- 5. Proposal on new web site. Lt/C Smith is still working on implementing a new web site, but believes it will not take place before September, requiring us to rent Dreamweaver for a few months.
- 6. Squadron Treasurer's Report. Lt/C Schoenthal reviewed revenues and expense for the past year, and noted that for Education, we spend approximately \$3,500 more than we took in. Walter Riley said that this was due to several factors: (1) Course materials on hand for future classes; (2) materials that we have bought from National that cannot be returned due to age or policy; and (3) the \$20/non-USPS student that we have to pay National. For the next fiscal year, we expect to have \$13,560 in expenses and expect that to be matched by revenue after including \$1,000 that will be transferred from our investments.
- 7. Storage location. We now have a new storage location for our materials and Lt/C Schoenthal urges everyone with materials needing storage to take advantage of this new site.
- The rules committee is not yet ready to present their recommendations for change to our bylaws. It was decided to have a special executive committee meeting in August to discuss the committee's findings. Time/date TBA by the commander.
- Joan Thayer presented a draft flyer for the August 17th event at the Essex Shipbuilding Museum. A motion was made, seconded and approved to make this an official event of the squadron. Commander Nigro will serve as backup to Lt/C Thayer on this event.
- 10. Commander Nigro said that he will experiment with a new member meeting format this September, which will include a "trivia night" in lieu of a speaker.

11. A motion was made, seconded and passed to donate flowers for the funeral/wake of longtime member Joan Bonner.
